Brightening Up Our Darker Nights

The nights are drawing in and we are busy in our gardens trying to keep our flowers flowering for as long as possible, taking cuttings for future plants and planning for next spring and summer. Nothing to be depressed about then and so much to look forward to.

Our speaker in September gave us an insight into using plants for life enhancing and medicinal purposes. Dr Gwenda Kyd science writer, editor and speaker gave a talk entitled 'People and Plants, Molecules, Medicine and Mischief'. She told us about the chemical properties of plants, how they are used in medicine and who discovered them, e.g. digitalis slows the heart beat and makes each beat stronger. But she also told us about using it for less kindly purposes! She was very informative about the use of garlic, hawthorn and horse chestnut. Not things we should try to self medicate!



Whitworth Way Play Area Improvements

The Parish Council is very pleased with the final outcome now that the new safety surface has been installed up to, and under, the multi-use climber frame. These projects take a long time to move forwards as there are so many different, and often unexpected, components to them. The Council wishes to thank Mark Brooks, Andy Collins and James Carroll for their efforts with this.

New Borough Council Ward Arrangements

As previously mentioned, there have been various consultations on the future ward arrangements for the elected Borough Councillor to represent Wilstead. Currently there is one Ward Councillor representing Wilstead and Wixams. It has been confirmed that from the next election Wilstead will join with Wixams, Stewartby and Elstow, forming a Ward which will be represented by three Borough Ward Councillors.

Christmas Lights Update

Work has been going on for a number of months already behind the scenes in preparation for this year's Christmas decorations. There is much excitement as additional decorations are looking to be sourced. The Parish Council has committed some funding towards the lights but if through additional fundraising more money can be raised then more of the of village can have decorations. Visual Improvements To The Parish

The Parish Council continues to pursue various options. We are pleased to have secured some bulbs which will be planted along Bedford Road and Luton Road ready for the spring.

Thanks also go to the volunteer litter pickers who have continued with their efforts, being out and about keeping the roadside verges tidy. This is an endless task and the Council is most grateful for residents giving their time freely to do this.

Also the Parish Council has recently replaced a well-used bench in the Churchyard/Burial Ground. A resident approached the Council seeking to give a home to the old bench, which the Council was pleased to arrange.

Reducing Speeding In The Village

At the September Parish Council meeting Councillors unanimously agreed to purchase vehicle activated signs for installation at various locations through the parish. The Parish Council is as fed up as residents with the issue of speeding and has been very frustrated that the Local Authority have still, after many months, not responded to the request for the Village to have additional average speed cameras as well as relocate the existing cameras to a more suitable location.

The signs being purchased will enable not just speed data to be captured, but also traffic volume data, and it is planned to publish all the results on the Parish Council website. These signs have proved to be invaluable in other local parishes where the data can be used to bring the Police into the village to carry out more enforcement, as well as the Local Authority camera van. As the signs are moveable it means they can capture data at a range of places throughout the village.


