Covid Vaccine Passport Scam

We have been made aware of a Covid Vaccine Passport Scam going around that purports to be from the NHS and informs recipients that they can apply for their 'Digital Coronavirus Passport'.

Clicking to the link within the email takes you to a convincing, but fake, NHS website that asks for personal and payment details (for an admin fee).

Although the website has been taken down please be aware that similar emails/websites may appear.

Your vaccination status is obtained FREE through the NHS App, website or by calling the **NHS on 119**

Village P3 Footpath Group Meetings

The May meeting was cancelled because of Covid and the July meeting is planned for the 10th. However this may be moved to later in the month following the latest road map.

Group members will be reporting on the footpaths and bridleways in the Parish which they will have recently surveyed, identifying any problems/issues with their path.

Borough Paths

It is still hoped to help the Borough undertake surveys of paths in other parishes. Depending on dates around 10 members of the group have said they would help with these surveys.

These surveys are now undertaken electronically rather than using pen and paper. We used to go as a group and then split up and do all/most of the paths within a allocated parish.. However a shortage of Borough tablets may result in changes to how the Group are involved this time.

One of the Group is to go on a Borough training course on how to use the tablet to record the state of the paths. They will in turn teach the rest of the Group.

Footpath Work

The recent wet and warm weather has meant that many of the paths around the village now need a mow and other minor footpath work has been identified. Hopefully this can be done in the next couple of weeks.

If you do spot any problems with the path surface or overgrowth or stiles/way mark posts etc then please contact the number below and the group will try and address it.

The June walk was cancelled following the delay to the COVID road map. Hopefully we will be able to resume the monthly walks in the near future, perhaps a Friday evening towards the end of July. Keep an eye out for posters on the noticeboards.

Watch Out For DVLA Scam Email

The following email has been received by a local resident. Please be vigilant and never click on a link in an email you are not expecting. When in doubt go directly to the website for that organisation and make your query that way.

The message read:

Your bank has told us that your recent Direct Debit Payment has been returned as you have cancelled your instruction.

As we have not been able to collect payment we have now cancelled your Direct Debit mandate and the vehicle is not taxed.

Failure to take one of the above actions may result in enforcement action being taken.

Theft of Motor Vehicles

The current Community Priority is vehicle offences, which includes *Theft of Motor Vehicle*, *Theft from Motor Vehicle and Interference with Motor Vehicle*.

Theft of Motor Vehicle offences were reported in the Abbeyfields area of Elstow at the end of May together with the report of an Interference with Motor Vehicle offence.

Although these offences took place outside of Wistead, it has been pointed out that all the vehicles targeted were those with the keyless entry/start. This is when offenders use a device to relay the key's signal from inside the house to the vehicle to unlock the car doors and start the engine.

PCSO James Dancer has strongly advised that if you have a vehicle with the keyless feature to use a Faraday Pouch to place your keys in while they are in your house. This helps block the signal to and from your key. If you do not have Faraday Pouch, a metal tin may help to block the signal. Also, try to keep your keys in an area of the house away from your car. For most, this will be away from the front door. The signal from your key will be weaker with the added distance.

Elstow Cricket Club

Local cricket club for Wilstead, Wixams, Elstow and other surrounding areas

At the time of writing, we can report that things at Elstow Cricket Club are going very well. The Saturday 1st XI have picked up their first 2 wins and are moving up the table in the FCCL Division 1 and whilst the 2nd XI haven't picked up a win for a couple of weeks, signs are very good with excellent contributions from several of the young players in the squad. On a Sunday, the 1st XI are currently 3rd in the Bedfordshire County League Division 2 while the 2nd XI made up almost entirely of U16 players are 4th and have had some fantastic results so far. In June, our Club Captain scored his first century of the season in a 70-run win over close rivals Thurleigh. This was topped however by young Henry Jones who smashed 150 off just 118 balls in an equally comprehensive win for the Sunday 2nd XI. Watch out for this lad in the future.

Our first team have also qualified for the Semi Finals in both the Heritage Cup and the East Beds Shield. The Heritage Cup semi will be against Flitwick at the Warren on Monday 28th June and should be a fantastic occasion for the Club.

The Elstow Rabbits (mid-week team) are also going well and whilst they are out of the cup, they currently sit 2nd in Division 1.

In youth cricket all our teams are going well with some significant wins. None better than defending 150 in the U15 county cup v Bedford CC. We continue to field strong teams at U9, U11 (2 teams), U13, U15 and we also field a team in the U18 East Beds Shield. Age group cricket continues to thrive under the watchful eye of our Youth Development Manager Geoff Couling.

The Elstow Belles (ladies/girls) team have also started their season. Whilst they don't have competitive matches, they train with just as much enthusiasm as the boys on a Tuesday evening. Any girls or ladies who are keen to join would be more than welcome whether you are keen to learn cricket or just need an excuse to join a club, do a bit of exercise and have some fun. All ages and abilities are more than welcome to join.

The All Stars Cricket Programme has started for boys and girls aged 5 to 8 years. Adam Ross and Fiona Tanswell lead the coaching with help from some of Elstow's finest young cricketers. All Stars Cricket is on a Friday evening from 6pm. We are always looking for coaches and helpers, particularly on a Friday so please get in touch if you would like to get involved.

Spectators are now allowed at The Warren and the refreshment bar (The Pigeon Toe Inn) is open on match days and Friday evenings. SMS Flubot Or Phishing Scams

Have you received an SMS message claiming to be from a delivery company lately informing you about a package arriving shortly, inviting you to click on a link to track its delivery status?

Mobile users across the globe (including many members of the Neighbourhood Watch community) have been receiving messages like the one below:

"DHL: Your parcel is arriving, track here: http://demo.minupet.cn/a/ etc. "

These messages are linked to a banking Trojan called 'FluBot' disguised as a legitimate text asking you to install a tracking app, intended to steal credentials and other personal data.

How to protect yourself from FluBot?

Install an antivirus solution that detects threats like Flubot on your mobile device.

You can protect yourself from FluBot and other mobile phishing attacks by following the advice below:

- Do not click on links in SMS messages Do not install software or apps on your devices.
- Err on the side of caution with any suspicious SMS. you weren't expecting. Contact the company on their legitimate website, to confirm the message received.
- Don't reply directly to suspicious communication - Always begin a new communication via the company's official service channels
- Train yourself to detect phishing messages.
 These tend to be generic as well as automated messages, or messages that present an offer that seems too good to be true.
- Do not install apps from anywhere but the official app stores. Set your mobile device's security to only install apps from trusted sources.

If anyone you know has had a message like this, please do share the above information with them.

Reporting Items If You See A Problem

There are many different ways to report something if you see an issue, and it is really helpful if residents can report items directly so they can be dealt with promptly.

Highways - Bedford Borough Council are responsible for the improvement, maintenance and development of the public highway network within Bedford Borough. This includes footways and public footpaths such as rights of way. If you need any further information or would like to report an issue then contact the Highways Helpdesk on **Highways.Helpdesk@bedford.gov.uk**

Environment – if you spot an over flowing litter bin, experience noise or nuisance, find some fly tipping, then this should be directed to the Borough Council via the Environment Helpdesk, who can be contacted on Environment. Helpdesk@bedford.gov.uk

If you are not sure whose responsibility something is, then do send an email to the Parish Clerk, Lizzie, who can then assist you with who will be able to help you with the matter. Sometimes it is not the Borough Council's responsibility, but it is the Parish Council, or the landowner's, and the Clerk will always try and guide you to find the right way to get the matter resolved.

Fraud Trends and Emerging Issues

The National Fraud Investigation Bureau (NFIB) produces monthly threat assessments outlining trends in fraud reporting and emerging frauds that are anticipated over coming weeks.

Some of the types of frauds where reporting has increased recently, as well as what to look out for in the coming weeks are summarised below:

Increases in reporting have been seen in:

- Online shopping fraud
- Door to door sales fraud
- Phone Fraud
- Investment fraud
- Rental fraud
- Computer virus and malware
- Mandate fraud (where fraudsters obtain details of direct debits, standing orders or account transfer details and amend them to transfer money to other accounts)
- Delivery company- branded smishing, with messages asking customers to click to a link to either reschedule or pay for an underpaid delivery charge
- Phishing scams involving text messages purporting to be from a bank stating that a new payee or new device has been added

Stay ahead of the fraudsters - emerging issues to look out for:

- Festival/concert ticketing fraud There has been a huge demand for tickets to festivals and concerts recently announced and fraudsters are expected to try and take advantage of the demand over coming months
- Holiday fraud Following a possible lifting of travel restriction for international travel, lowcost private testing systems offering Covid testing for holidays are like to be overwhelmed. Fraudsters may look to take advantage of this by offering reasonably priced tests
- Post-vaccine survey scams People are being contacted by email and/or text message after receiving the COVID 19 vaccine to participate in an fraudulent survey with the promise of a prize or cash at the end. Credit card information is requested but after being charged for shipping and handling fees, the promised prize is never received. Although victims appeared to be based in the USA at present it is likely that this sort of fraud will be attempted in the UK.
