### An Update from Greensand Surgery

You may have seen on the news that from Monday 17th May, doors at GP Practices were 'reopening'. As you will know, our GP practice has been open throughout the pandemic, offering patients telephone and online appointments, with face to face consultations available to those who need them. This was in line with national requirements to keep patients safe, whilst COVID infection rates were high and before the vaccination was widespread.

GP practices are being encouraged to offer patients a choice of whether they would like a remote or face to face consultation. However, before we have more people coming into the surgery to see us in person, we need a bit of time to put in place measures to keep everyone safe. As we wait for further national guidance on doing that, we ask that patients continue to contact us by phone or online as you have been doing. We are facing unprecedented demands to our services and will need to continue to adjust how we use our clinicians' time to best support our patients – particularly those who need us the most.

We will keep you updated as soon as we are clear about how we can re-open our reception areas safely. Thank you for your support.

The Parish Council had its first face to face meeting on Monday 17th May after over twelve months of online remote meetings. As the government legislation no longer allows online meetings, it is expected that the next meeting, the Annual Parish Electors Meeting will go ahead at the Village Hall on **Monday 21st June** at 7pm, everyone as always is welcome.

#### **New Parish Council Appointments**

At the May meeting, Eric Benton was elected as Chair to the Parish Council, and Mark Brooks as Vice Chair, along with Marc Frost as Responsible Financial Officer. The Parish Council wish to thank Nigel Jacobs enormously for his hard work and meticulous attention to detail during the twelve years he was Chair. Thankfully, Nigel remains as a Councillor so his extensive knowledge and skills will be retained within his role of Spokesperson for the Planning Working Group.

#### **Parish Council Noticeboards**

The Parish Council agreed to fund some new noticeboards for the village, to enable better communication to residents. The new boards will be crafted locally, and are significantly more fit-for-purpose than the previous style. They will be located outside the Village Hall, and at The Crossroads in the first instance and will also be more user friendly.

Village Agents provide a free, confidential service and are here to help people over 65 with a variety of issues - large or small. We are funded by Bedford Borough Council. We are all DBS checked and operate in the strictest confidence. Andrea is the Village Agent for Wilstead.

#### **Door to Door Transport in Bedford Borough**

- Do you struggle to get on a bus? Did you know that the Door2Door minibus service will collect you from home, and has facilities to take wheelchairs and mobility scooters using a tail lift?
- A subscription costs £30 for the first year and £20 annually thereafter (Minimum charge per journey £3.00).
- The minibuses operate between 9:15am to 4:15pm, weekdays only. You need to book your journey two days ahead - or earlier for health-related appointments.
- Did you know that you can sign up for Door2Door without giving up your bus pass?
- Call the Door2Door admin number on 01234 834933 for more details.

#### Would a helpful gadget make your life easier?

Do you need a carbon monoxide alarm, a disabled toilet key, personal safety alarm, a handy grabber for picking up items or a 'good grip' potato peeler suitable for arthritic hands? Andrea has a few useful items to give away free, but be quick before they all go! Contactless Covid safe delivery.

**Jigsaw Loan Scheme** - We have a large number of jigsaws to lend, most with 500 or 1000 pieces. We also have wordsearch and puzzle books to give away. If you are interested, call Andrea for more details.

Help with form filling - Many older people aren't claiming the benefits they are entitled to. Andrea can help identify which benefits you can claim by doing a confidential benefits check. We can also help you fill in those complicated forms such as Blue Badge and Attendance Allowance forms. We are now able to carry out face to face outdoor visits, or we can provide telephone support and advice.

# **Doorstep Crime**

### Not sure? Don't open the door

- Keep your front and back doors locked, even when you are at home.
- Install a 'spy hole' or electronic viewer in the front door so that you can see who the caller is before opening the door.
- Use a door chain or door bar so that you don't have to open the door fully to talk to the person on your door step.
- Even if the person calling has an appointment, carefully check their identity card.
- If the caller claims to be from a particular company, you can check by calling the company in question using a number from a phone book. Don't use a card or number given to you by the caller. Close and lock the door while you check. A genuine caller won't mind waiting.
- Don't leave any doorstep caller alone with your door open.



### **Common Types Of Email Scams**

419 Emails: You are offered a share in a large sum of money in return for helping to transfer it out of the country. Once you have given the criminals your bank account details, they empty your accounts.

**Phishing:** An email that purports to be from companies such as banks designed to trick you into revealing your personal information and passwords.

Pharming: Pharming is a term used when you are directed from a link in an email to a website that spoofs a legitimate website in order to access your personal details.



#### **How To Spot A Scam Email**

Impersonation of UK official websites: For example HMRC with an email message claiming you are due a refund and requesting your bank account details or directing you to a website link.

Impersonation of UK officials: Criminals impersonate a UK official to obtain personal information and steal money, often claiming that you are due a refund or must make an urgent payment. Examples of this scam include TV License, the HMRC Tax Rebate and the Council Tax Scam.

Investment scams and pension scams: Emailed offers of worthless, overpriced or non-existent shares, or a time-limited opportunity to convert some or all of your pension pot into cash.

The sender's email address looks suspicious: Roll your mouse pointer over the sender's name to check it. If it doesn't match the website address of the organisation it says it's from it could be a sign of a scam.

The email doesn't use your name: It says something like 'Dear customer' instead.

**There's a sense of urgency**, asking you to act immediately.

There's a prominent website link that may look at first glance like the proper address but has one letter missing or is spelt wrong.

There's a request for personal information.

Poor grammar and spelling mistakes.

The entire text of the email is contained within an image rather than the usual text format, and the image contains an embedded hyperlink to a bogus site. Again, roll your mouse pointer over the link to reveal its true destination. But don't click it!
